All efforts are made to achieve 100% adherence in retreatment. In order to achieve this objective, the following services are provided to the patients: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Small nutritional support from the group of protein rich food. ii. Health and nutrition education to patients and their family members. iii. Counselling to TB patients and build confidence in them that they would recover after completing the treatment course. iv. The Red Cross volunteers make regularly home visit of the patients to reduce social stigma about tuberculosis. v. Regular mohalla meetings and group meetings are held by the project staff with the help of Red Cross volunteers and community leaders. <p>At present the T.B.
