(i) FIRST AID TRAINING TO DRIVERS AND CONDUCTORS OF BUSES

It is submitted that training in First Aid is mandatory for the conductor license. The First Aid certificate is issued by the St. John Ambulance (India), which remains valid for three years and to be renewed for further next three year after getting First Aid training from St. John Ambulance (India). It has been observed that First Aid certificate is not renewed by the Bus Drivers and Conductors.

It is proposed that one day First Aid Refresher training may be imparted to all Drivers and Conductors of Haryana Roadways as well the private transporters for renewal of their First Aid Certificates. The State Transport, Haryana may be asked to issue directions to all District Transport Authorities for First Aid Training to Bus Drivers Conductors before expiry of First Aid Certificates
