Item No. 6	<p><u>REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2020-2021 REGARDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GIVEN TO THE PERSONS LIVING UNDER PROVERTY LINES OUT OF HARYANA CHIEF MINISTER'S RELIEF FUND</u></p> <p>As per the notification bearing No. CMII-2GA-2003/4032-4051 dated 4th September, 2003 that the Haryana Govt. took the decision to provide medical facility to the poor and needy patients suffering from only three exceptional diseases cases i.e. (1) Heart Surgery (2) Kidney Transplantation (3) Cancer Surgery living below poverty line or poor financial conditions through Civil Surgeon of the concerned District. These cases are to be forwarded to the special duty-cum-member Secretary, Administrative Committee, Haryana Chief Ministers fund, Haryana Civil Secretariat alongwith the requisite documents. In this regard this office passed the resolution in the Sub-Committee meeting of Hospital Welfare Section held on 13th October, 2017 that the District Red Cross Branches will provide the assistances to these patients under the said scheme. Accordingly 33 cases were forwarded by the District Red Cross Branches to Haryana Chief Minister's fund, Haryana for consideration.
